

The Problem With Personal or Ancestral Freemasonry

Why is Freemasonry “bad”?

For many reasons. Of most interest to you in this case are probably the effects that Freemasonry can have on an individual and their family line. The short answer to this is that Freemasonry exposes a person to the occult, lies, deceptions, heresies, and blasphemies. These give “legal ground” to the enemy and his minions to follow and affect the person’s life and family.

- Freemasonry is a religion that runs counter to a biblical view of God. (heresy, blasphemy)
 - "Every Masonic Lodge is a Temple of Religion and its instructions are teachings in religion." Pike p213¹
- Freemasonry has very strong ties to the occult, particularly the Kabbalah (occult, mysticism, heresy, witchcraft)
 - "Masonry is a search after light, which leads us directly back to the Kabbalah (tradition of mysticism and magic)." – Pike p741²
- Freemasons are a “Secret Society”, relying on secrets that are only revealed the longer one is associated and the more dedicated one proves to be (lying, deception, idolatry)
 - Lower level members are still exposed to the more extreme oaths and rituals that higher degrees are exposed to
- Masonic mysticism draws false connections to equate Christianity to other religions (heresy, universalism, blasphemy)
 - "It has been shown that every event in the drama of the life of Jesus Christ and every quality assigned to Christ, is to be found in the life of Krisna." Buck³
- Masons are taught that they must conceal everything about Freemasonry from outsiders, including friends, children, and spouses (deception, secrecy, distrust, hindered intimacy)
 - Introduces harmful patterns of deception and secrecy into families
- Some Masons are taught that the fraternal bond includes protecting fellow Masons from legal punishment, and respecting Masons above all other people (lying, judgment, idolatry)
- Masons may be taught that while they are to respect the chastity of female relatives of other Masons, women not related to Masons do not enjoy the same preservation (sexual sins, elitism)
- Masons swear oaths as part of initiations that include graphic depictions of the torture they would receive if breaking the oath. These blood oaths exposes the Masons to the demonic (occult, idolatry, consorting with the demonic)
- Masonic texts (such as those mentioned above by Pike and Buck) are full of heresies and perversions of Christian doctrine (heresy, idolatry)
- Shriners are an offshoot of Freemasons, and may need the same responses

Responding to Freemasonry in yourself or your family

You have the authority as a believer in Christ to take back this legal ground and reclaim the purity Jesus purchased for you. The prayers and/or sessions scheduled for you will walk you through renouncing the lies, oaths, and curses established in your life and cleanse you from anything that may be lingering.
